Athletic Code of Conduct for Parents

Over the past several seasons of Indian Community School Athletics we have experienced numerous problems with the conduct of some of our community members. They have been witnessed by staff members as well as reported by league officials, referees and other parents/community members. We at the Indian Community School believe that we represent the school and our community no matter where we are or what day of the week it is. We want our students, parents and staff members to follow the 7 Sacred Gifts (Bravery, Humility, Love, Loyalty, Respect, Truth, and Wisdom) at all times. Therefore, we want parents and guardians to pledge to be responsible for their words and actions while attending Indian Community School Athletic events (home or away) and they shall conform my behavior to the following Code of Conduct:

1. *I will not participate in or encourage any unsportsmanlike conduct with any coach, player, official, parent, or participant.*
2. *I am responsible for my behavior and actions as well as the behavior and actions of those people that are attending the event with me. If those that attend with me or those around me do not conform to the ICS Athletic Code of Conduct, I will be brave enough to remind them of how to represent ICS.*
3. *I will not engage in or encourage any behavior which would endanger the health, safety, or well-being of another parent, player, participant, official, or other attendee.*
4. *I will not use drugs or alcohol while at a youth sports event and will not attend, or participate in a youth sports event while under the influence of drugs or alcohol (This includes smoking which is illegal on any school grounds).*
5. *I will not engage in the use of profanity or derogatory statements.*
6. *I will treat any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee with respect regardless of race, creed, color, national origin, sex, sexual orientation or ability. I will encourage my child to do the same.*
7. *I will not engage in verbal or physical threats or abuse aimed at any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee. I also will not post disparaging remarks about coaches, parents, or other players on any social media.*
8. *I will at no time participate in a verbal or physical altercation with any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee. No matter what the other person says or does I will stay calm and represent my school community according to the core values. If there is a problem I will report it to a coach, or the person in charge of the gym.*
9. *I will clean up any mess I or my guests create during the sporting event.*
10. *I will not park in designated handicapped parking spots unless my vehicle is equipped with the proper tags and their owner.*
11. *I will encourage my child to uphold their agreement to ICS athletics by making sure they attend practice regularly with a good attitude.*
12. *I will help my child uphold their agreement to ICS athletics by making sure they attend games in a punctual manner or letting their coach know when they are unable to.*
13. *I will help my child uphold their agreement to ICS athletics by making sure they have passing grades in all classes as well as no missing work. They are student athletes, so any failing grades will result in students missing their game that weekend. Grades are checked each Friday. Parents with Internet access can check student grades on the PowerSchool Program. If parents do not have Internet access, they can ask their student to bring home a printout of their grades, students have access to their online grades.*
