Athletic Code of Conduct for Students

Over the past several seasons we have experienced numerous problems with a few of our student athletes. They have occurred in school and outside of school. We at the Indian Community School believe that we represent the school and our community no matter where we are or what day of the week it is. We want our students, parents and staff members to follow the 7 Sacred Gifts (Bravery, Humility, Love, Loyalty, Respect, Truth, and Wisdom) at all times. Therefore, we want student athletes to pledge to be responsible for their words and actions while attending Indian Community School Athletic events (home or away) and they shall conform their behavior to the following Code of Conduct:

1. *Student athletes will be respectful to themselves and others at all times.*
2. *Student athletes will follow all school rules and remind those that are having a hard time following the rules how to act appropriately.*
3. *Student athletes will be honest when communicating with others (teachers, parents, and teammates).*
4. *Student athletes will attend practice and games with a good attitude and give their best effort at all times. By playing a sport you have made a commitment to something bigger than just you. Your teammates are counting on you to do your part to make the team successful. (T.E.A.M.=Together Everyone Achieves More).*
5. *Student athlete's behavior and attitude should bring honor and respect to themselves, their team, and their school.*
6. *Student athletes are students first and athletes second. Student athletes will maintain passing grades at all times, or they will not be able to participate in games for their sport.*
7. *Student athletes will not be kicked out of class, you cannot learn if you are not in class.*
8. *Student athletes will not have missing work (practice is not a reason for skipping work, there are very few good reasons to not stay caught up in your work).*
9. *Student athletes will not use any controlled substance (tobacco, drugs, alcohol, etc.)*
10. *Student athletes will not bully their teammates or any other student.*
11. *Student athletes will display appropriate behavior (this includes but is not limited to: moving others belongings, stealing others belongings, horseplay, vandalism, and fighting).*
12. *Student athletes will model and display good sportsmanship at all times. Students should be humble in victory and brave/respectful in defeat. Talking back to coaches and referees will not be tolerated. Quitting on your team also is unacceptable.*
13. *Student athletes will make it to games and practices on time unless a phone call or note is provided by a parent/guardian.*
14. *Student athletes will obey and follow all community laws.*
